GUIDELINES FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF FREE DAY SECONDARY EDUCATION FOR THE YEAR 2021-2022

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Purpose

This circular is issued in accordance with Article 48 of the Public Finance Management (PFM) Act, 2012 and Article 39 of the Basic Education Act, 2013, to provide guidelines for the utilization of the Government Subsidy to Secondary schools in the implementation of Free Day Secondary Education (FDSE) programme for the Year 2021-2022.

SPECIFIC GUIDELINES

1.2 FDSE Capitation to Schools

The Government will continue to disburse the GOK subsidy (Capitation) to schools to actualize Free Day Secondary Education (FDSE) following the normal financial calendar at the rate of KES.22,244.00 annually per learner as stipulated in Table 1.
